

Shellshock Vulnerability Announcement

Update Wednesday 10.01.2014

The Shellshock vulnerability ([CVE-2014-7169](#)) remediation effort has been successfully completed. With this magnitude of change in the environment, there is always some concern that unexpected issues could arise, we at CrownPeak are pleased to report that the remediation effort is complete and there was no unexpected down-time for our customers.

We reviewed our systems to determine where this vulnerability might apply and the following remediation steps were taken:

- Amazon Web Services (AWS) technologies in use by CrownPeak which were exposed to the “Shellshock” vulnerability have been updated.
- AWS applied updates to a large majority of their servers and infrastructure and rebooted servers to complete the update process.
- The CrownPeak Support and IT Operation teams completed monitoring of the update process and continue to ensure high-availability of the CrownPeak CMS and Client Hosting environments.

At CrownPeak we strive to maintain the highest level of security awareness, and will continue to monitor and react quickly when issues such as these arise. If you have any questions regarding the impact of the “Shellshock” vulnerability, please contact us.
